## **MISSIONS**

#### **CWS HYGIENE KIT:**

One hand towel measuring approximately 15" x 28" to 16" x 32" (no fingertip, bath, dish towel or micro-fiber)

One washcloth

One wide-tooth comb removed from the package

Must be sturdy with at least 6 inches of teeth

No pocket combs or picks

Rattail and combs without handles are acceptable

One fingernail or toenail clipper removed from the package (either one is acceptable)

One bath-size bar of soap in the original package

One toothbrush in the original package

Ten standard size Band-Aids

Place items inside a one-gallon Ziploc type bag.

## **CWS SCHOOL KITS:**

Three 70-page count spiral bound notebooks or notebooks totaling 200-210 pages (no loose-leaf or filler paper)

One pair of blunt scissors removed from the package (round tip, only)

One 30-centimeter / 12" ruler

One hand-held pencil sharpener removed from the package

One large eraser (no pencil cap erasers)

Six new, unsharpened pencils with erasers (removed from packing and use a rubber band to hold the pencils together).

One box of 24 crayons (only 24)

One 12"x14" to 14"x17" finished size cotton or lightweight canvas bag with handles (solid color or kid-friendly fabric, no logos, reusable shopping bags or backpacks)

#### All items must be packed inside of the bag. We have bags made by our church ladies.

*Optional:* Loose school kit items may be placed in a large Ziploc type bag to keep them together. Remove the air, seal the bag and place inside of the cotton/canvas bag.

Do NOT add any extra items to either bag.

Three Voices Congregation will cover the cost of shipping and processing.
