Hello, Three Voices! I continue to be amazed at all of the folks willing to get up into the pulpit to lead a service ... I bet none of you had ever done anything in church on that level before.

If you also are excited to see the many different faces each week looking out at you from up front, and maybe interested in doing it also but just not really sure what it entails, let me share some of the behind-the-scenes magic with you.

There are suggested readings for each day as well as a book filled with all of the sections for you to choose from in preparing a service. You can use that or write your own service from scratch. I base my sermons usually around the reading for the day, but even that is not carved in stone.

But the best part is, you can do what you want. If you don't feel moved by a particular suggested passage for the day you can do something else altogether. You can even change your mind once you are in front of the congregation - the only rule is to serve the church as the spirit guides you.

Give it a try - I bet it will grow on you and strengthen your own faith at the same time!

**Leule Asefa** is our newest sponsored child through Compassion International. He turned 12 years old on September 26th. He lives in the town of Tigregna in Mekele, Ethiopia with his parents and siblings. Tigrena is a mountainous community, home to approximately 38,000 residents. Typical houses are constructed of dirt floors, mud walls and tin roofs. The primary ethnic group is Tigrain and the most commonly spoken language is Tigregna.

There are not many employment opportunities for his parents. He attends the Maychew Fullgospel Believers Church Child, Development Center. He runs errands and his hobbies are sports and children's games. His grade level is about 3rd grade. He likes science.

The regional diet consists of maize, sorghum and wheat. Common health problems in this area include parasitic diseases and HIV/AIDS. Most adults in Tgrian work as day laborers and earn the equivalent of \$36 per month. This community needs housing, tuition assistance and income generating activities.

Our sponsorship allows the staff of Maychew Fullgospel Believers Church Child, Development Center to provide your sponsored child with Bible teaching, health screenings, indoor and outdoor games and educational assistance. The center staff will also provide health education and evangelism for the parents or guardians of your sponsored child
